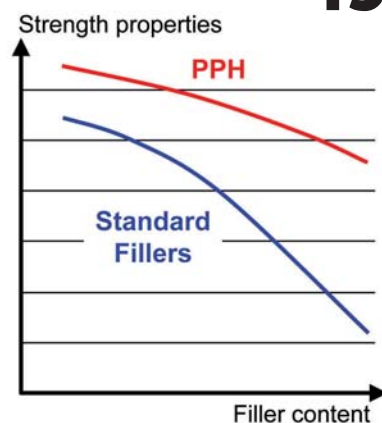
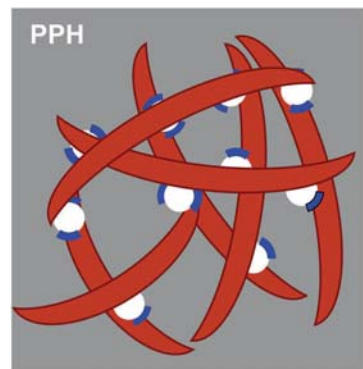

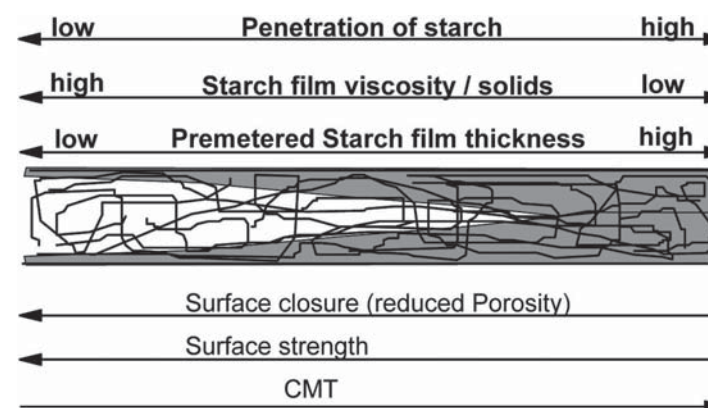

Effects of starch parameters on penetration and paper properties



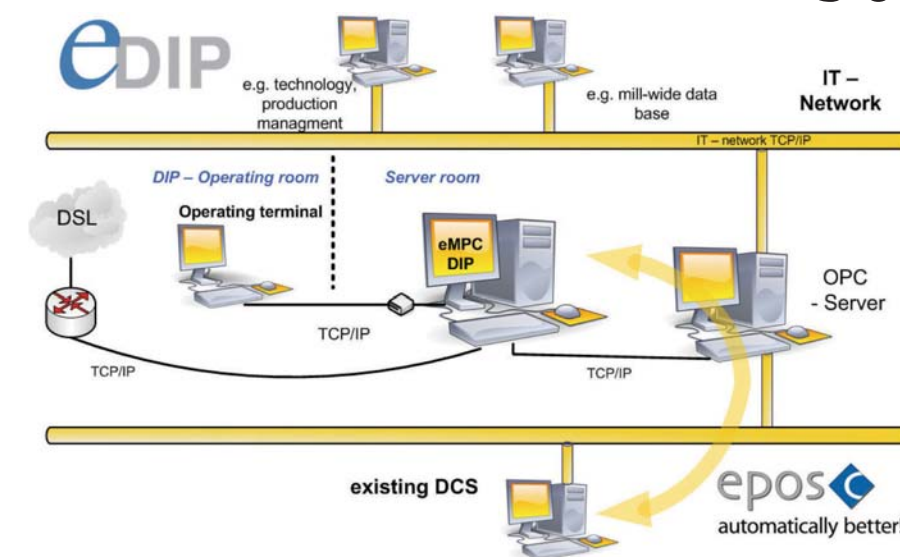
